Radiate Behaviour Policy

St Benedict's is a school sixth form and as such refers to and utilises the RADIATE behaviour policy from main school. The students are familiar with it and it provides clear guidance. Our aim is to create a behaviour strategy rigorous enough to enable our Catholic values to radiate from and through every student in everything they do.

The three key rules for classroom conduct are:

- 1. Be prepared
- 2. Be on task
- 3. Allow others to learn.

The Code of Conduct provides a simple and effective structure for all students:

- Arrive to lesson on time with the correct equipment
- Sit in a seat directed by the teacher
- Follow staff instructions the first time
- Listen to the person who should be talking
- Mobiles must be out of sight
- Do not interfere with the work of other students
- Be respectful to others at all times

Staff are authorised to confiscate items from students where there are reasonable grounds for doing so. The member of staff holds responsibility for the safety of student property until such time that property is returned to the student or their parents/carer or handed to the Radiate team for safe keeping (in a safe).

Mobile phones, MP3 players, smart watches or headphones are not permitted to be used by students outside of the sixth form area or designated supervised study areas. If any of these items are being used on the main school site, it can be confiscated by staff (all staff members are permitted to confiscate these items) and a C3 issued. **Set the example to lower school.**

If a student refuses to hand over their phone/electronic device/ headphones, it will result in further sanctions.

If there are persistent offenders, contact will be made with home and they will be asked to collect the item from school and meet their Progress Leader regarding the repeated breaking of school rules.

The nature of this contract is one of good faith. Any reasonable request should be carried out by students and we expect all sixth formers to act as exemplary role models to other students across school. Any deviation from this is not acceptable.
