



St Benedict's Dress Code

The St Benedict's uniform signifies the maturity and seniority of the Sixth Form students and as such should be worn with pride. It is important we set standards; St Benedict's students are acting as role models to support the whole college community.

All students are expected to adhere to the dress code outlined below. Items can be purchased from Rawcliffes, Henry Smiths and Natasha's School Wear.

All students

- · Trutex sky blue button collar shirt of sky blue revere collar shirt
- Navy blue pullover with St Benedict's Sixth Form logo badge
- St Benedict's 6th Form tie to be worn with the blue button collar shirt
- Plain black suit style trousers (no jeans, denim or straight leg fashion style) **OR** St Benedict's standard black pleated skirt (no tube skirts or other variation)
- Plain black shoes (no pumps, trainers, trainer style shoes or boots)
- Optional plain black or blue Hijab

Students may wear one ring, one pair of stud earrings worn in the lobe, a simple bracelet or watch. A small and discrete nose stud piercing is allowed, no other facial piercings are permitted.

Hair colour should be natural, extreme colours such as pink, blue or green are not allowed. Hair styles and make-up should be sensible and professional. Nail colour should be pale pink or neutral tones, acrylic nail extensions are not permitted.

It is important to remember that it is a professional dress code and prepares you for future life. If we need to ask a student to amend or correct their dress an opportunity will be given to do this within a reasonable time and taking any extenuating circumstances into account. If this is not successful, we reserve the right to send students home until such time the amendment has been made.

The Lanyard is an important part of the uniform and relates to safeguarding within school. It will also be used to mark yourself present for independent study periods and to exit/access the school site during break and lunch. As such it should be worn at all times. Loss or damage will mean that you will need to purchase a new one.
